Book Page Roses

Supplies:

Hot Glue Gun
Old Book
Scissors
Pencil
Floral Stem Wire
Toothpick

1. Cut out 3 squares from old book pages.
2. Fold squares diagonally in half 3 times.
3. Cut folded end off to create a small hole in the middle.

4. Then cut other into a dome shape to form the petals.
5. Unfold your paper and cut them so you have 1,2,3,5,6 & 7 petal pieces.
6. Glue closed your 3,5,6 & 7 petal pieces so they look like little flowers.
7. Then curl the petals, and curl the 1 & 2 petal pieces to form cones.

Time to start assembling...

8. Now put some hot glue around the bottom hole of your 6 petal flower and stick onto top of 7 petal flower.

Then hot glue the bottom of your 5 petal flower and glue onto top of 6 & 7 petal flowers...

Keep gluing on the smaller layers until you have your rose!

9. If you would like to put a stem on your rose, put some hot glue on the end of the stem and stick on bottom of rose.

Tips!

Try and glue your layers so the petals are asymmetrical to give it a more authentic look.

The bigger the square paper you cut, the bigger your rose will be! Explore with different sizes.

Book Page Roses

Then hot glue the bottom of your 5 petal flower and glue onto top of 6 & 7 petal flowers...

Keep gluing on the smaller layers until you have your rose!

9. If you would like to put a stem on your rose, put some hot glue on the end of the stem and stick on bottom of rose.

Tips!

Try and glue your layers so the petals are asymmetrical to give it a more authentic look.
